 they were at the t\_\_\_\_\_ of their c\_\_\_\_\_.

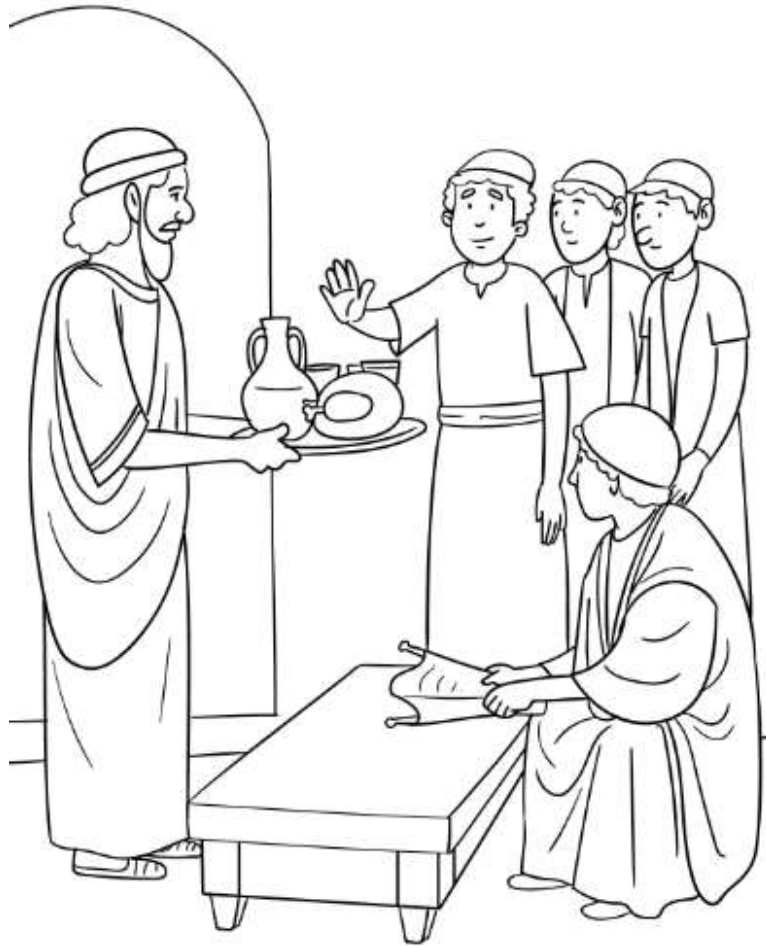
