Philemon 4-7 - Paul begins by c Philemon and					
addresses him as a "b," or an equal.					
Philemon 8-9 - Instead of exercising a to command					
Philemon to do, Paul a to him instead.					
Philemon 13-14 - Paul does nothing without Philemon's c					
Philemon 16 - Paul acknowledges Philemon's r over his own					
Philemon 17 - Paul calls him "p," again as an equal.
