### Moses’ Obnoxious Objections

Exodus 4:1 - Moses obviously i\_\_\_\_\_ what the Lord told  
him in Exodus 3:18.

“If you want to do something, you’ll find a w\_\_\_\_. If you don’t want

“What if...” are words of worry, which is a form of u\_\_\_\_\_,

### Moses’ Ordinary Object

what He wants for our lives.


