

## Questions Jesus Asks #4 “Empty Words” Luke 6:46

### A Disingenuous Distinction

Luke 6:43-49; Matthew 7:15-27 - In both texts Jesus distinguishes between good and bad t\_\_\_\_\_, tells a parable about a wise and a foolish b\_\_\_\_\_, and speaks of those who say, “Lord, Lord.” To call anyone “Lord” admits that a\_\_\_\_\_ is owed.

James 2:14-17 - Faith unaccompanied by action is d\_\_\_\_\_.

Titus 1:16 - “They c\_\_\_\_\_ to know God but by their actions they d\_\_\_\_\_ Him.”

### A Divine Disapproval

Matthew 7:21-23 - The “many” who are turned away are not b\_\_\_\_\_ people necessarily; they just don’t k\_\_\_\_\_ Jesus.

Matthew 7:23 - These are not evil believers or evil speakers but evil d\_\_\_\_\_.

Matthew 7:21; John 6:28 - To “do the work of God” means to b\_\_\_\_\_ in the one He has sent.

### A Dedicated Discipleship

Luke 6:47 - A true disciple c\_\_\_\_\_ to Jesus and h\_\_\_\_\_ His words, and p\_\_\_\_\_ them into practice.

James 1:22-25 - H\_\_\_\_\_ is not enough. Hearing must lead to d\_\_\_\_\_.

John 14:15-24 - Jesus said, “If you love me, you will o\_\_\_\_\_ what I command.” There is no other way to follow Jesus.

Luke 6:46 - Either s\_\_\_\_\_ calling Him Lord, or s\_\_\_\_\_ doing what He says!

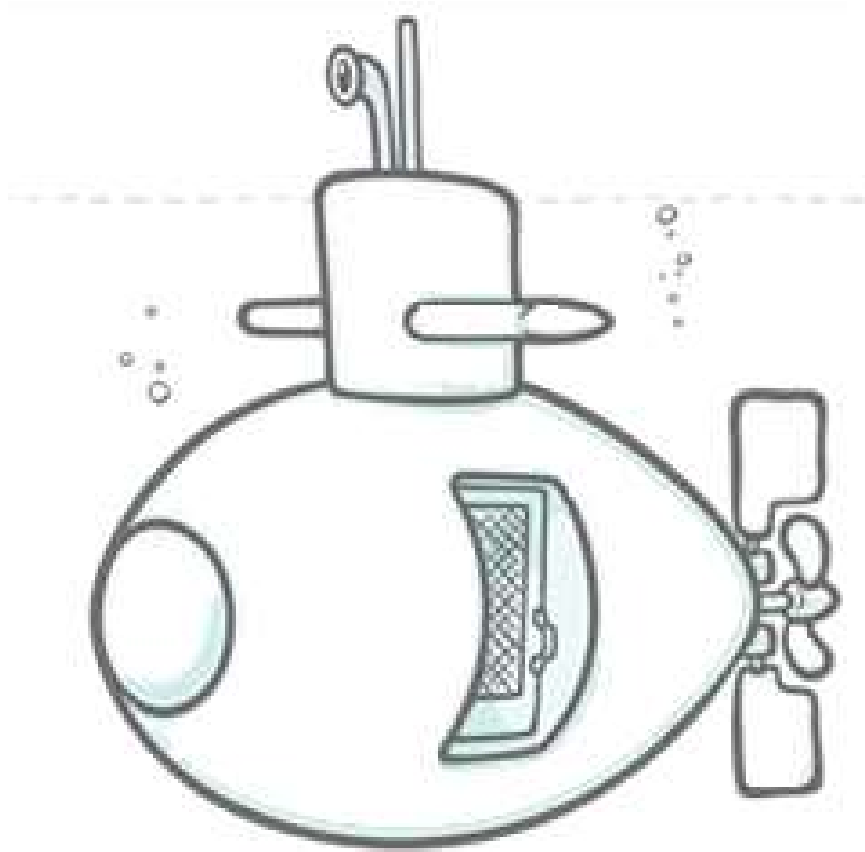
